

We Gather Together

We offer Sunday school for all ages. We have three adult classes which include Contemporary Issues for the young and young at heart, Pilgrims and Prodigals and the Fielding Russell Class both use the Present Word curriculum.

For young people we have classes for grades kindergarten through fifth grade, middle school and high school. There is also a separate college ministry on Sunday mornings.



Sunday Morning

We offer a fully staffed nursery for infants through age 4 during all Sunday services including Sunday school AND during our Wednesday night supper, Bible study and choir practice.

We share God's love with our children through Children's church for grades kindergarten through fifth grade. This begins after the time for children in the morning service and continues through the duration of our Sunday morning worship service.

Each quarter, our congregation enjoys a covered dish dinner in the fellowship hall after the 11:00 a.m. Sunday morning worship service.

Wednesday Night

Wednesday night's focus is on fun and fellowship for the whole family. Our catered meal costs \$7.50/adult and \$3.00/child. The meal is complimentary for college students who reserve a place by 12:00 noon on Sunday. Our evening activities include:

- Handbell and choir rehearsal
- Acolyte practice – first Wednesday only

Presbyterian Women – The four circles of the women's fellowship offer a variety of schedules and subjects of study.
